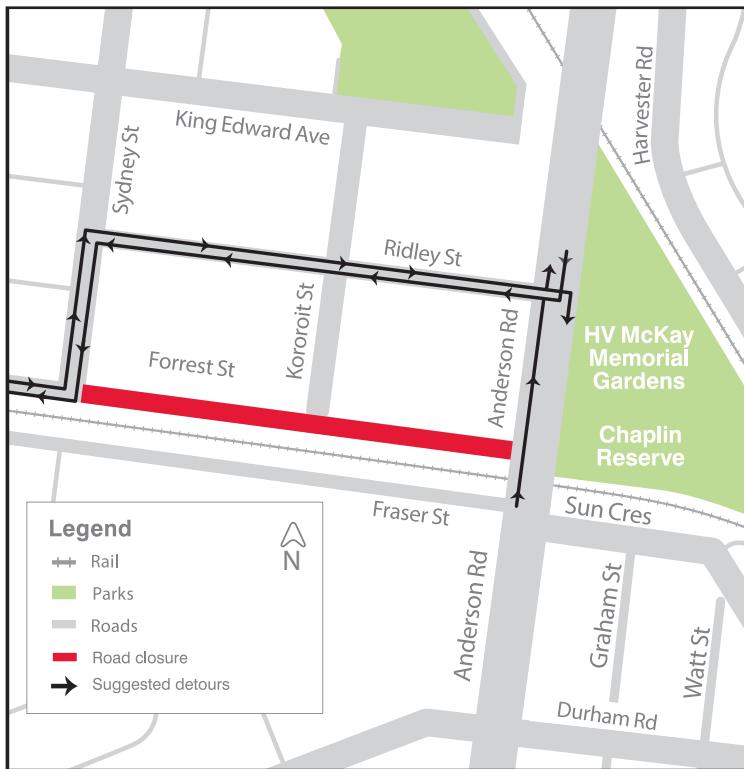
# Forrest Street Road closure

### From 8pm Monday 10 June

As part of the Regional Rail Link project, the Footscray – Deer Park project team is removing two level crossings on Anderson Road, Sunshine. To achieve this long-term improvement, there will be significant traffic disruptions in the area over the coming months.

**Forrest Street will be closed between Sydney Street and Anderson Road from 8pm Monday 10 June for approximately six weeks to lay a new gas main under the road.**

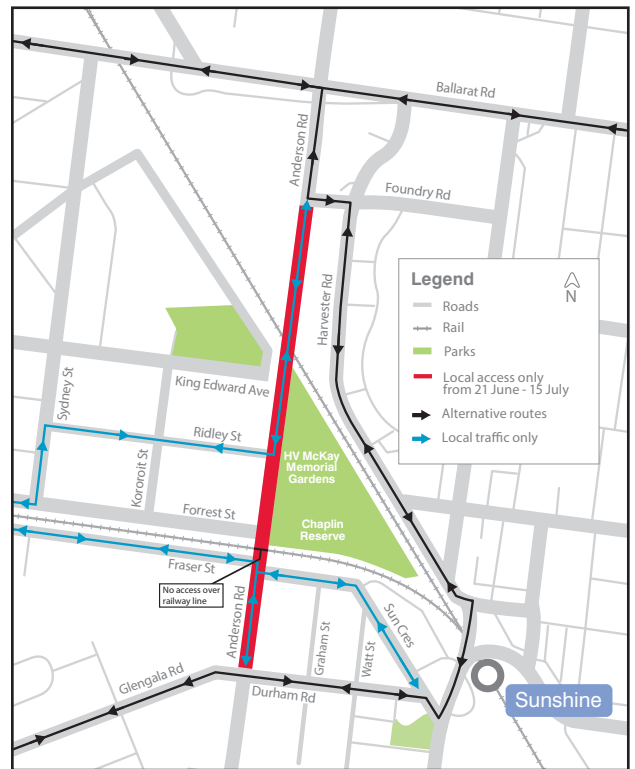
There will be continued detours for east-bound traffic until late August. Delays are expected and motorists not travelling locally are advised to seek alternative routes.



# Anderson Road closure

### 21 June – 15 July 2013

Anderson Road will be restricted to local traffic between Durham Road and Foundry Road from **late on Friday 21 June until early on Monday 15 July 2013**. Vehicles will not be able to cross the railway line near Sun Crescent during this time. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
