PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. To be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

Withdrawing Nominations

If a ballot is required, withdrawal of nominations is permitted prior to the printing of ballot papers. Further information regarding this will be provided at the close of nominations.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open at 12:00pm (AEDT) on 12/11/2018 and close at 12:00pm (AEDT) on 30/11/2018.

Scrutineer Appointment

As per the registered rules of the Union, candidates are entitled to appoint a Scrutineer who may be present at all stages of the ballot. The appointment of scrutineers closes at 12:00pm (AEDT) on 30/11/2018. A Scrutineer Appointment form is available from the Returning Officer.
